Maximum dimensions and weight allowed on an annual oversize permit are:

- Up to 75' long x 12'5" wide x 13'10" high, 80,000 lbs. (unlimited distance, no routing required.)
- Up to 100' long x 14'6" wide x 13'6" high, 80,000 lbs. (movement restricted to 50 miles radius unless trip mutes are obtained.)
- Up to 100' long x 16' wide x 13'6" high, 80,000 lbs. (trip route must be obtained.)
- Up to 1 00' long x 8' wide x 13'6" high, 80,000 lbs. (movement restricted to 50 miles.)
- Up to 75" x 12'5" wide x 13'6" high, 80,000 lbs. (maximum dimensions for hay.)

Carrier will be responsible for obtaining necessary route approval prior to move. The Iowa Detour and Embargo map should be used to obtain information for self routing.

Disclosure Statement: The information furnished on this application will be used by the Department of Transportation to prepare and issue permits. All information applicable to a given permit is required and is public information. Failure to complete the application as required will result in denial of permit.
